To Alberta's Commercial Painters:

In September of 2008 a Commercial Paint Roundup was held over a 3-day period during which time over 65,000 litres of paint was dropped off by the commercial sector for recycling.

Based on the response to this event a second roundup is scheduled for September 22-23, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. at the same locations as last year (detailed below). This will once again provide commercial painters a free service to drop off any backlog of old paint for recycling or proper treatment by registered processors. The materials accepted include latex, alkyd (oil based), stains, and aerosols (please see the complete list of eligible and ineligible materials on Alberta Recycling's website at [www.albertarecycling.ca](http://www.albertarecycling.ca)). Please do not bring any ineligible or hazardous materials to the roundup.

Alberta Recycling is proud to partner for this event with the Cities of Edmonton and Calgary as well as Calibre Environmental Ltd. Since the paint program's inception in April, 2008, more than 2.4 million litres of paint has been collected and recycled by registered processors.
